GUIDELINES

KNOWLEDGE BASED COMPETITIONS

1) Quiz Competition

Team entry -2

Rules:

- Only team entries are eligible.
- A team shall consist of max two persons
- It is a general knowledge based Quiz Including Sports, Entertainment, Food, Animal world, Science & technology, Digital innovation.
- Time limit to answer a question is 45 sec
- Question Patterns - Verbal questions (24), Audio Visual (12), Buzzer Round (12) & Spell Bee (6)
- Rapid fire of 10 questions between the teams having tie (answer time 3 sec.)
- Marking Scheme – For Correct answers +10, For Incorrect answers -5.
- Question will be forwarded to next team after no response for 45 seconds.
- The decision of the quiz-master will be final and will not be subjected to any change.
- The participants shall not be allowed to use mobile or other electronic instruments.
- The questions shall be in the form of multiple choice, True / False statement, Specific-answer question etc.
- Audience shall not give any hints or clues to the competitors.
- Replacement of any participant of a team is not allowed after registration.
- Teams selected for the final rounds will be allowed to give themselves an appropriate name related to the competition by which they may want to be known.
- **Audio-visual round**
 - Teams will be shown clips and will have to answer.
 - *10 marks for the correct answer and negative 5 marks for the wrong answer
 - *Each Team would be asked 2 audio-visual questions. (1 slide in each round)
 - *Answering time is only 30 seconds.
 - *No passing to the next team.

2) YOUTH PARLIAMENT COMPETITION

Team entry (min 2)

- Objective of the Youth Parliament Competition

With a view to strengthen the roots of democracy, to inculcate healthy habits of discipline, to tolerate others views and to enable the student community to know about the working of Parliament, our college has decided to organize a Youth Parliament competition for school students.

- Duration of Youth Parliament sitting

The duration of ‘Youth Parliament’ for preliminary round is 40 minutes and for final round it is 20 minutes. Out of this 10-12 minutes may be devoted to Questions and the remaining time is to be utilized for discussion on Bills, Motions or Resolutions, etc.

- Subjects for discussion at the Youth Parliament

It would be desirable that the matters raised in the Youth Parliament may relate to the subjects such as welfare activities, defense of the country, social justice, social reforms, economic development, communal harmony, health, student’s discipline etc. No direct or indirect remarks may be made in the speeches so as to cast or persons in political parties or leaders etc. It is suggested that the concept of human rights may be stressed upon and at least one item of business on this subject may invariably be included.

- Language

The participants are expected to speak in English

- Committee of Judges

The Competition will be evaluated by a panel of 2 judges.

- Prizes

Following Prizes will be awarded:-

- A trophy to the school
 - Certificates to the participants
 - Cash prize
- Considerations for drawing up the merit List

The Committee of judges shall keep in view the following points while assessing the performance of institutions:-

CREATIVE TALENT BASED COMPETITIONS

1) Fashion & Jewellery Designing (SKETCHING)

Solo participation

- They must be original, unpublished works that does not contain, incorporate or otherwise use any content, material or element that is owned by a third party or entity.
- Theme is “Young India”.
- Judging Criteria:
 - Theme
 - Creativity
 - Originality
 - Composition & Design

2) Singing Competition

Solo participation

- Time allotted for each performance is 2-3 minutes.
- Participants will not be allowed to refer to the lyrics while singing.
- The participants will be judged on the song selection, voice quality, clarity, rhythm and their appeal to the audience.
- The participants should bring their own musical instruments if required in the performance.
- Choice of song is open to the participants but the song should not have any slangs or derogatory language.

3) On Spot Poetry

Solo participation

- All poems must be 30 lines or fewer.
- Poem should not be copied from any other poet.
- Multiple entries are not allowed.
- On the day of the competition, the contestants will be given 1 hour to draft and finalize their poems. If necessary, a ten-minute extension will be given. The poem may be written in either English or Hindi.

4) Character Dramatization

Solo participation

- Poise: Posture, characterization, command of performance
- Originality: Imagination in use of props, scenery, choreography, ideas
- Use of Space: Effective use of gesture, movement, props
- Dramatic Techniques: Timing, rhythm, entrances and exits
- Delivery: Appropriate voice or action
- Expressive Aspects: Emotional intensity, expression and body language
- Characterization: Appropriate development of character
- Costuming or Dress: Appropriate attire and/or make-up for character
- Degree of Difficulty: Appropriate for performer's maturity and ability
